P: In the name of the Father,

**C: Who has made us and all people;**

P: And of the Son,

**C: Who lived and died that all people might live;**

P: And of the Holy Spirit,

**C: Who has given us a second birth.**

## CONFESSION

P: Brothers and sisters in Christ, we are not worthy to be in the presence of this Holy God. But he has promised that if we confess our sins, he will purify us from all unrighteousness. Therefore, let us confess our sins to him.

**C: We confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We confess that so often we think, speak, and behave as if your abiding presence makes no difference in our lives. Instead of allowing Christ to be exalted in all things, we seek to exalt ourselves. We fail to trust that he is present and at work in all our circumstances. Do not cast us from your presence, Lord. Forgive us, and restore to us the joy of your salvation.**

P: Be of good cheer! God holds the cross of his Son before your eyes and assures you that your sins have been paid through his atoning sacrifice. Therefore, as a called servant of the Word, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

### **PSALM 27**

P: Having received the forgiveness of sins, we can now enter with joy into the presence of God, and we can be assured of that presence in all the circumstances of our lives. There is nothing to fear! The LORD is my light and my salvation –

**C: Whom shall I fear?**

P: The LORD is the stronghold of my life –

**C: Of whom shall I be afraid?**

P: When evil men advance against me to devour my flesh,

**C: When my enemies and my foes attack me, they will stumble and fall.**

P: Though an army besiege me, my heart will not fear;

**C: Though war break out against me, even then will I be confident.**

P: One thing I ask of the LORD, this is what I seek:

**C: That I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD and to seek him in his temple.**

P: For in the day of trouble he will keep me safe in his dwelling;

**C: He will hide me in the shelter of his tabernacle and set me high upon a rock.**

P: Then my head will be exalted above the enemies who surround me;

**C: At his tabernacle will I sacrifice with shouts of joy; I will sing and make music to the LORD.**

**ALL: Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.**

**FIRST LESSON: Habakkuk 3:16-19** <sup>16</sup>I heard and my heart pounded, my lips quivered at the sound; decay crept into my bones, and my legs trembled. Yet I will wait patiently for the day of calamity to come on the nation invading us. <sup>17</sup>Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls, <sup>18</sup>yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will be joyful in God my Savior. <sup>19</sup>The Sovereign LORD is my strength; he makes my feet like the feet of a deer, he enables me to go on the heights.
